



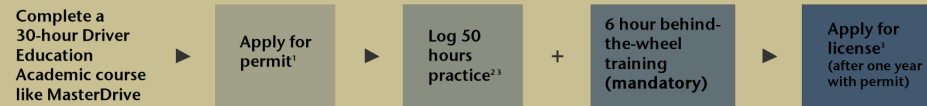

# steps to getting your license

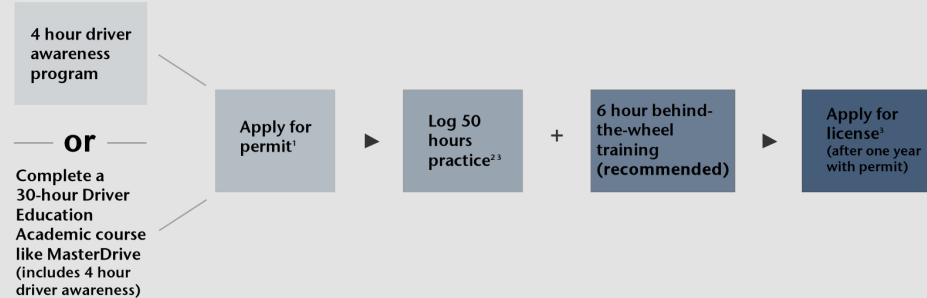
## COLORADO

More training is *always* a better option than less training. Requirements for training change based on your age when you begin the process.

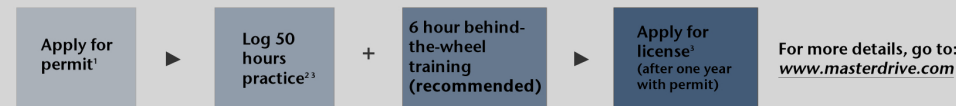
### GDL process started at age 15 - 15 1/2

<sup>1</sup> All new drivers under age 18 require a parent/legal guardian's signed Affidavit of Liability and Guardianship to get an instruction permit. Whoever signs the Affidavit is responsible for the supervision of the minor's driving and for any financial liability.

<sup>2</sup> Logged drive time must be with an authorized, licensed parent, legal guardian or alternate permit supervisor appointed by the parent/guardian. Ten of those hours must be at night.

### keep your license

#### **ZERO Tolerance for Impaired Driving - No Drinking!**

Minors aren't allowed even a trace of alcohol, but any drug that impairs your driving can have the same consequence.

#### **Buckle Up**

When a minor is driving - *everyone* in the vehicle must be belted or you may get pulled over.

#### **Passengers**

- First six months - 21 and older only
- Second six months - only 1 person under 21 (siblings and medical emergencies allow some exceptions)
- Even with a bench seat, only one passenger in the front seat

#### **Cell Phone Use & Texting**

**Illegal** for under 18 while driving. Hands-free is illegal too. Avoid temptation - turn it off! Texting is illegal for everyone.

#### **Curfew**

Between midnight and 5 a.m. - Local curfews may be more stringent.

Graduated Driver Licensing (GDL) laws help new drivers ease into the risk and responsibility of driving "gradually". The most challenging time is early on and carries the most restrictions.
